The Stories of the Storytellers – How the Gospels Came to Be

The first attempts to write the life of Jesus--the Gospels-- were products of social and religious reconstruction in the period after the war, ranging from roughly 70 to after 100 C.E. This presentation looks at how these stories were passed down before they were written, and how the writing of each Gospel reflects the experiences and circumstances of early Christians. They do not all tell the same story of Jesus because each one is responding to a different audience and circumstances. For example, Matthew's gospel is clearly written for a Jewish Christian audience; it is the most Jewish of all the gospels.
