



Divine Mercy Sunday

The Sunday after Easter the Church celebrates **Divine Mercy Sunday.**

Jesus told St. Faustine: "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.

The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me even though its sins be as scarlet." A deed of mercy to our neighbor was also asked by Jesus.

The Novena of Divine Mercy which consists of nine days of prayer said privately, beginning on Good Friday prays for the intention to bring souls back to our loving Savior. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is also said and may be continued daily throughout the year. The novena booklets may be obtained at the doors of the church.

The Divine Mercy Holy Hour will include adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Veneration of the Divine Mercy Image and the relic of St. Faustina, and Benediction.



GOSPEL Matthew 21:1-11

When Jesus and the disciples drew near Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find an ass tethered, and a colt with her.
