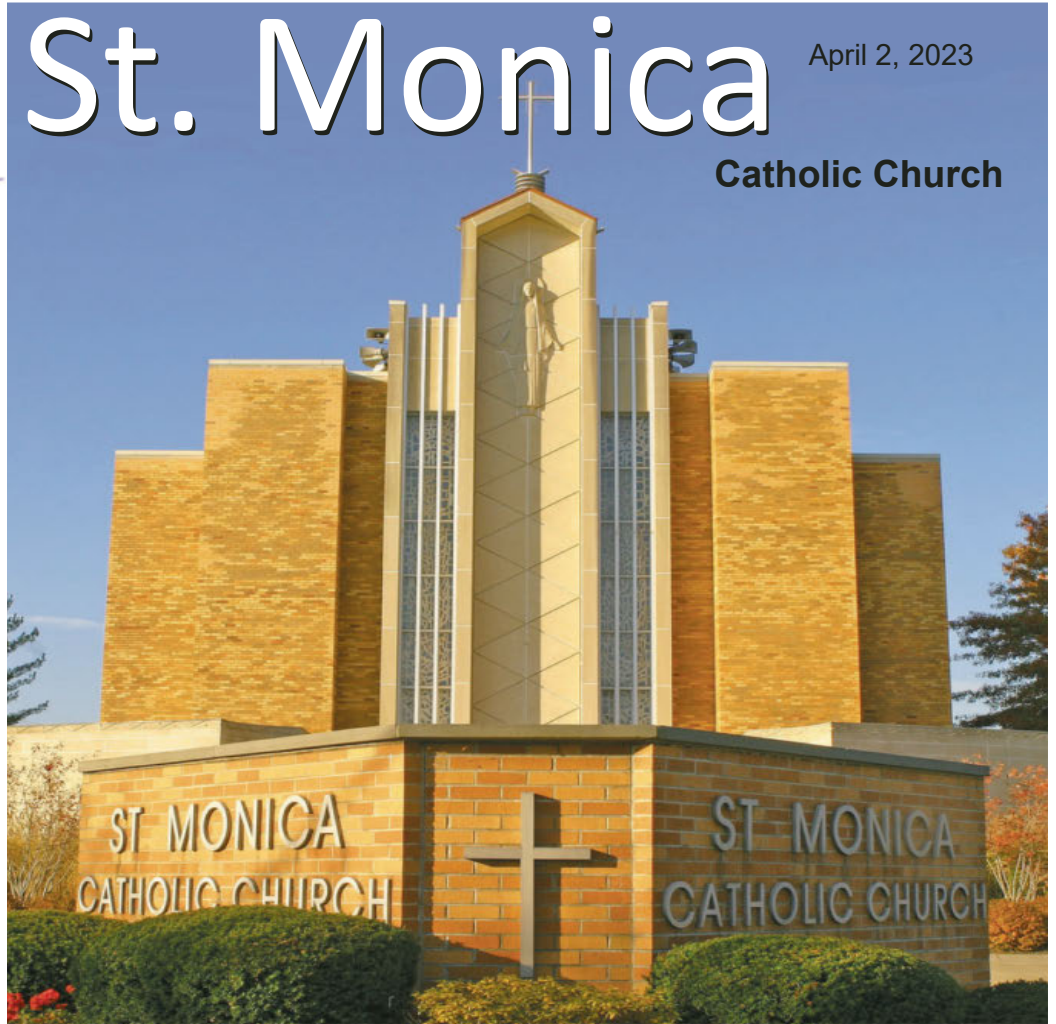

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA):** Adults and school-age children seeking full membership in the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist can make an appt. to continue their conversion process by calling the Parish Office.

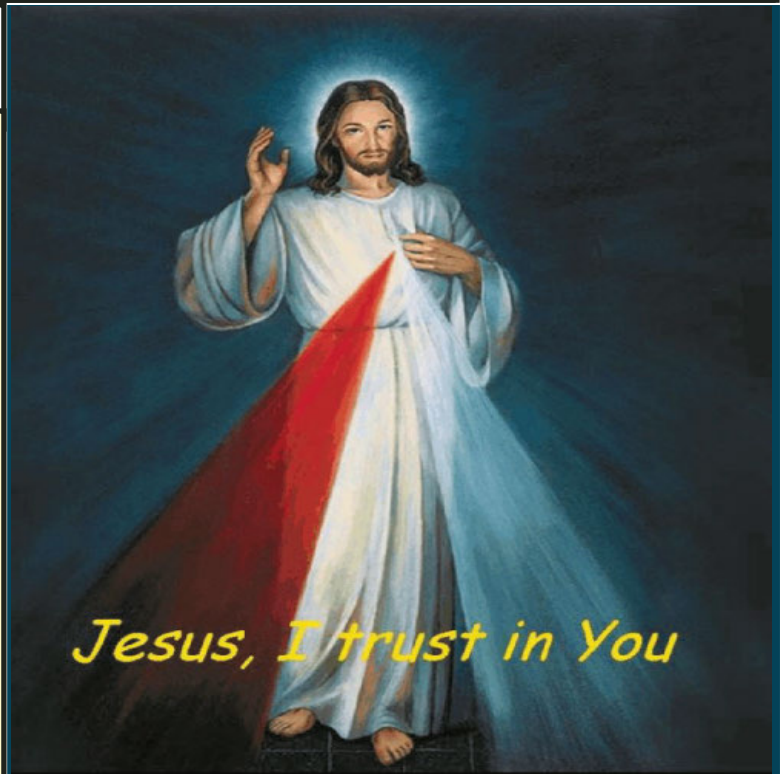

**Divine Mercy Sunday**

The Sunday after Easter the Church celebrates **Divine Mercy Sunday.**

Jesus told St. Faustine: "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.

The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me even though its sins be as scarlet." A deed of mercy to our neighbor was also asked by Jesus.

**The Novena of Divine Mercy which consists of nine days of prayer said privately, beginning on Good Friday** prays for the intention to bring souls back to our loving Savior. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is also said and may be continued daily throughout the year. The novena booklets may be obtained at the doors of the church.

The Divine Mercy Holy Hour will include adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Veneration of the Divine Mercy Image and the relic of St. Faustina, and Benediction.

**GOSPEL** Matthew 21:1-11

When Jesus and the disciples drew near Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find an ass tethered, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them here to me. And if anyone should say anything to you, reply, 'The master has need of them.' Then he will send them at once." This happened so that what had been spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled:

*Say to daughter Zion,  
"Behold, your king comes to you,  
meek and riding on an ass,  
and on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden."*

The disciples went and did as Jesus had ordered them. They brought the ass and the colt and laid their cloaks over them, and he sat upon them. The very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and strewed them on the road. The crowds preceding him and those following kept crying out and saying:

"Hosanna to the Son of David;  
blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord;  
hosanna in the highest."

And when he entered Jerusalem the whole city was shaken and asked, "Who is this?" And the crowds replied, "This is Jesus the prophet, from Nazareth in Galilee."

Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God,
