Pastoral Scene

In the celebration of the Ascension, we encounter a clarion call, reminding us that we are a Royal Priesthood, a Holy nation, a chosen race, a people set apart- that is us – Priesthood of the faithful.

A feast to remind us of our dignity, our calling, our mandate and duty. As Jesus said to his Disciples- Behold I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. Remember we have received this promise at baptism. Remember we are Church!

The late **Archbishop Fulton Sheen** reflects on the Ascension his book: *Life of Christ*: Jesus did not lay aside the garment of flesh with which He had been clothed when He went to heaven. There was a heresy in the early Church called Monophysitism. (This name came from two Greek words: mono = “one” and physis = “nature.”) This heresy held that once Jesus had accomplished the work of our salvation and returned to heaven, He cast off the human nature He took from the Virgin Mary and retained only the divine nature He had from all eternity. If our Lord had done this, then He would not have had a glorified humanity which would be the pattern for our glorified humanity in heaven. Furthermore, Jesus, keeping His human nature in heaven as the Son of Man along with His divine nature as the Son of God, retained the greatest sign of His incomparable love for us because He remains one of us, one of our human family, for all eternity.

Jesus, who was humiliated on earth in His three-fold mission as teacher, King and Priest, has now been vindicated by being in the place of Glory at the right hand of His Heavenly Father. We are reminded that the world that hated Him will also hate us because we have chosen to follow Him. But we must also remember that He has overcome the world and has won the final victory over sin and death. If we persevere with Him, we shall share in that final victory with a glory that no one can take from us, because we will be glorified in Christ in His Heavenly Kingdom!

Please be aware of the faithful praying before Mass. We should all **observe Sacred Silence** to prepare for the Eucharist.

We **congratulate the newly ordained in the Diocese** who will begin their new assignments next month. If you know of anyone interested in a vocation, please call me.

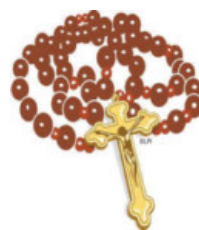

# Dignity of Life Threatened in Ohio

A Catholic perspective on the proposed constitutional amendment to expand and enshrine abortion in our state.

## WHAT IS HAPPENING?

A proposed amendment to Ohio's Constitution claims to recognize reproductive freedoms, but it furthers a culture of death and removes current safeguards for women. As Catholics, we find the proposed amendment dangerous, unjust, and contrary to our belief in the sacredness of all life.

# Where Does the Amendment Say That?

## PUTS WOMEN AT RISK



- Vague language would challenge any attempt to regulate who could perform an abortion and the standards of care required
- Could eliminate current safety standards, such as the presence of a licensed physician and assurance of hospital access in an emergency

“The State shall not... interfere with...an individual’s [abortion]... unless the State demonstrates that it is using the least restrictive means”

## ENDANGERS PREBORN CHILDREN



- Would force Ohio to abandon protections enacted for preborn children with a detectable heartbeat
- Permits abortions at any time in pregnancy; a clinician could justify a woman’s anxiety or depression as a reason for late-term abortion

“...in no case may such an abortion be prohibited if in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient’s treating physician it is necessary to protect the pregnant patient’s life or health”

## ENABLES THOSE WHO PRESSURE WOMEN INTO ABORTIONS



- Majority of women who have had an abortion report “high levels of pressure” to seek the abortion\*
- Anyone who transports, counsels, or pressures a woman into an abortion, including abusers, traffickers, and negligent clinicians, would be protected by law
- Parents would no longer need to give consent or even be informed if their minor is seeking an abortion, removing their ability to report suspected abuse of their daughter

**FIRST READING**    Acts 1:1-11

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

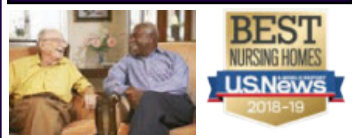
