TRAVELING MADONNA

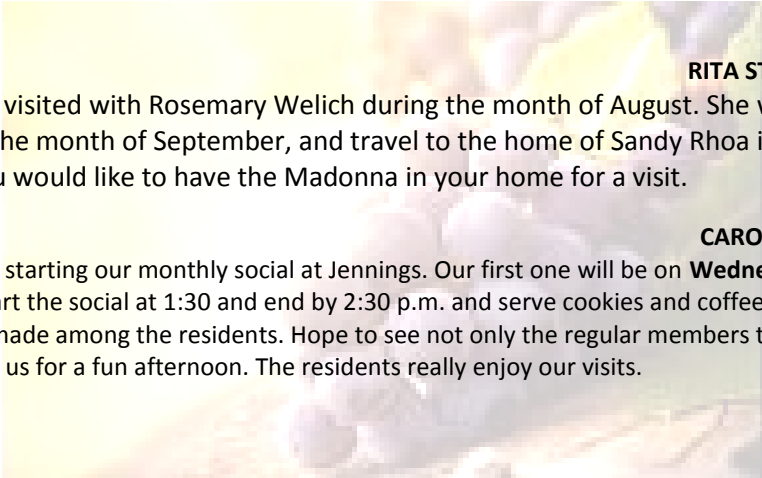
