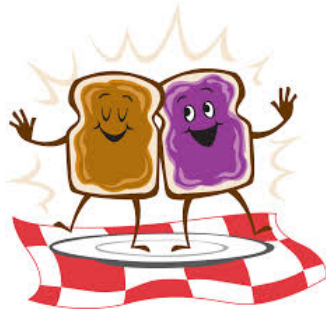


Sandwich Saturdays



During this Year of Mercy as declared by Pope Francis, a beautiful new act of kindness will start up this Advent season for anyone who would like to participate.

Once a month, individuals and/or families can come together on the 1st Saturday morning of the month to make peanut butter and jelly sandwiches which will then be delivered to the Front Steps Housing Shelter (formerly called Transitional Housing which was started by some Ursuline Nuns) near Lutheran Hospital or to St. Ignatius Labre Ministry that distributes directly to the homeless on the streets of Cleveland.

How it works:

For those individuals and families who would like to come and help make the sandwiches, we ask that you please bring the following supplies:

Jar of Peanut Butter

Jar of Jelly

Sandwich baggies

Dates are scheduled in the St. Joseph Room in the Parish Office beginning at 9:00 am:

December 5, January 9 (due to the Holiday), February 6, March 5, April 2, May 7, June 4, off July, August 6, September 10 (due to the Holiday), October 1, and November 5.

There are other ways you can help:

If you are unable to attend but would like to donate some of the needed items, please bring them to the Parish Office the week of the scheduled "Sandwich Saturday".

We will also need people who would be willing to deliver the sandwiches each month. They are on a rotating basis starting in December with the St. Ignatius Ministry.
